| <p>3. Name of the register</p> | <p>Companies interested in the business premises of Helsinki Airport</p> |
| <p>4. Purpose and legal basis for processing personal data</p> | <p>The purpose of the processing of personal data is to collect the contact details of entrepreneurs interested in business premises in order to contact them when suitable premises become available. The legal basis for the processing is the data subject's consent.</p> |
| <p>5. The recipients of the personal data</p> | <p>Personal data will not be disclosed to third parties outside Finavia, nor will it be used for any commercial purposes other than those related to the leasing of business premises at Helsinki Airport.</p> |
| <p>6. Data content of the register</p> | <p>Data recorded concerning the data subject:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - name - company - company's field of operation - company website - email address - telephone number - additional information and a detailed description of the company's operations |
| <p>7. Data sources</p> | <p>Personal data is collected directly from the data subject via the contact form available on Finavia's website: https://www.finavia.fi/en/business-premises/commercial-premises-finavia-airports?navref=main</p> |

| <p>8. Disclosure and transfer of data outside the European Union or the European Economic Area</p> | <p>Personal data contained in the register will not be disclosed or transferred outside Finavia, nor will it be transferred outside the European Union or the European Economic Area.</p> |
| <p>9. Data retention period</p> | <p>Personal data contained in the register will be retained for 12 months, after which the data will be deleted.</p> |
| <p>10. Principles of data protection</p> | <p>Personal data contained in this register is protected by technical and organisational measures against unauthorised and/or unlawful access, alteration, destruction or other processing, including unauthorised disclosure and transfer of data.</p> <p>The data is stored in electronic systems protected by firewalls, passwords and other appropriate technical safeguards. Access to the register is restricted to designated employees of Finavia Corporation and other specified persons who require access to the data for the performance of their duties. All persons with access to the data are bound by confidentiality obligations.</p> <p>Finavia Corporation complies with strict data security requirements in the access management and monitoring of its IT systems. Employees who process personal data as part of their duties receive regular training and guidance on data protection and information security.</p> |
| <p>11. Right of access and the exercise of this right</p> | <p>Upon providing the information necessary to identify the relevant records, the data subject has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether personal data concerning them is being processed and, if so, access to such data, or confirmation that no such data is held in the register. The controller shall also inform the data subject of the regular sources of the data and the purposes for which the data is processed and regularly disclosed.</p> <p>A data subject wishing to exercise their right of access as described above shall submit a request to the controller identified in section 1 of this privacy policy in a document bearing the data subject's handwritten signature or otherwise reliably verified.</p> |
| <p>12. Right to data portability</p> | <p>Where the data subject has provided personal data concerning them to the controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, they have the right to have those personal data transmitted to another controller, where:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) the processing is based on the data subject's consent or on a contract between the controller and the data subject; and b) the processing is carried out by automated means; and c) the transmission is technically feasible. |
| <p>13. Right to withdraw consent</p> | <p>Where the processing of personal data is based on the data subject's consent, the data subject has the right to withdraw their consent at any time. A request to withdraw consent shall be submitted to the controller identified in section 1 of this privacy policy in a document bearing the data subject's handwritten signature or otherwise reliably verified and delivered by email. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to such withdrawal.</p> |

| <p>14. Right to rectification, erasure and restriction of processing</p> | <p>The controller shall, without undue delay, on its own initiative or at the request of the data subject, rectify, erase or supplement any personal data contained in the register that is inaccurate, unnecessary, incomplete or outdated in relation to the purposes of processing. The controller shall also take measures to prevent the dissemination of such data where the data may compromise the data subject's right to privacy or their rights.</p> <p>At the request of the data subject, the controller shall restrict the processing of personal data where the data subject contests the accuracy of their personal data or where the data subject has claimed that the processing is unlawful and has opposed the erasure of the personal data and requested the restriction of its use instead. The controller shall also restrict processing where the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of processing, but the data subject requires it for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims. In addition, the controller shall restrict processing where the data subject has objected to the processing of personal data pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation, pending the verification of whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject.</p> <p>Where processing has been restricted on the above grounds, the controller shall inform the data subject before the restriction of processing is lifted.</p> <p>Requests for rectification shall be submitted to the controller identified in section 1 of this privacy policy.</p> |
| <p>15. Right to lodge a complaint</p> | <p>The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority if Finavia Corporation has not complied with applicable data protection legislation in its operations.</p> |
| <p>16. Contact details and exercise of rights</p> | <p>The data subject shall primarily submit requests concerning their rights via the following form: https://www.finavia.fi/en/data-protection/information-request or alternatively by contacting the controller identified in section 1 of this privacy policy.</p> <p>Finavia Corporation may request the data subject to specify their request and to verify their identity before processing the request. Finavia Corporation may refuse to comply with a request on grounds provided for in applicable legislation.</p> <p>Finavia Corporation shall respond to requests within one (1) month of receipt of the request, unless there are specific grounds for extending this period.</p> |
| <p>17. Automated decision-making and profiling</p> | <p>Personal data contained in the register is not used for automated decision-making or profiling.</p> |
| <p>18. Amendments to the privacy policy</p> | <p>Finavia Corporation continuously develops its business operations and therefore reserves the right to amend this privacy policy by publishing notice of such amendments on its website. Such amendments may also be based on changes in applicable legislation. Finavia Corporation recommends that data subjects review this privacy policy regularly.</p> |
